



The Department of Labor has (DOL) released its 2024 inflation-adjusted civil monetary penalties that may be assessed on employers for violations of a wide range of federal laws, including the Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSH Act). The increased amounts apply to civil penalties that are assessed after Jan. 15, 2024.

The following table provides an overview of OSHA's adjusted penalty amounts. Employers should become familiar with the adjusted penalty amounts and review their safety protocols to ensure compliance with federal requirements.

Type of Violation	2023 Penalty	2024 Penalty
Posting Requirements	Up to <b>\$15,625</b> for each violation	Up to <b>\$16,131</b> for each violation
Serious Other-than-Serious	Up to <b>\$15,625</b> for each violation	Up to <b>\$16,131</b> for each violation
Failure to Abate	Up to <b>\$15,625</b> per day until the violation is corrected	Up to <b>\$16,131</b> per day until the violation is corrected
Willful or Repeated	Between <b>\$11,162</b> and <b>\$156,259</b> per violation	Between <b>\$11,524</b> and <b>\$161,323</b> per violation
Repeated	Up to <b>\$156,259</b> for each violation	Up to <b>\$161,323</b> for each violation
